## Total Tick Lists: Life, Big Years, Big Months, Big Days

Total Ticks are the number calculated by adding the separate county lists together into one total, regardless of the time boundary used (i.e. a day, month, year or lifetime). Key: \* = last updated in 2009 # = last updated pre-2009 *(updated 2/28/11; compiled by Eric Walters & Joe Lill)* 

## Total Illinois Counties List (Total Ticks - 1000 minimum)

A number of birders added over 500 total ticks to their Illinois Life List. The top four places remain the same. However, Michael Baum's extensive explorations have allowed him to have a life average of over 100 species per county. He also jumped two places, into fifth overall position. Both Baum and Craig Taylor were able to pass the 10,000 total tick barrier this past year. Another big jump was made by Thad Edmonds, who moved up five places, and into the top 10 overall. Currently, one needs to exceed 8000 total ticks to be in the top 10, over 7000 to be in the top 15 and, factoring in at least two other unreported tallies, one needs 6000+ to be included among the top 20 for this list.
